 - (b) Name the narrator in Agatha Christie's novel, *The Murder of Roger Ackroyd*. What is his uniqueness?
 - (c) How is Ralph Paton related to Roger Ackroyd?
 - (d) What clues does Poirot find on the floor of the summer house at Fernly Park?
 - (e) What made Dr. Sheppard think that his neighbour "couldn't be a hair dresser after all"?
 - (f) Who dies first and who dies last in *The Murder of Roger Ackroyd*?
 - (g) 'There would be a kind of poetic justice'.—Identity the speaker. What does he mean?
 - (h) Comment in brief on the last episode panel of *Tintin in Tibet*.
 - (i) How does Tintin reach the monastery of Khor-Biyong?
 - (j) What actually happens to Tintin when the Captain rebukes him for his supposed sneezing after dinner at Hotel des Sommets?
 - (k) Who formed the team for the rescue of Tintin's friend and who eventually made their way to the crash site?
 - (l) What, in the cave near the site of the aeroplane crash, assured Tintin that Chang had survived the accident?
 - (m) What was the real name of Herge? To which country did he belong?
 - (n) How is the creature that Tintin refers to as the Abominable Snowman known in Nepal and in Tibet?
 - (o) What reason did the Captain give for his visiting Tintin at Charahbang village?

2. Answer any four of the following questions:

- (a) In *The Murder of Roger Ackroyd*, how does Christie prevent the reader from suspecting Dr. Sheppard as the criminal?
- (b) What was the glittering thing discovered in the goldfish pond of Fernly Park? Indicate the 'three theories' that evolved around it at the Mah Jong Party in Sheppard's house. 2+3=5
- (c) Briefly describe the character of the murderer in *The Murder of Roger Ackroyd*.
- (d) Assess the character of Captain Haddock in *Tintin in Tibet*.
- (e) What is the role of Chang in *Tintin in Tibet*?
- (f) What did the newspaper report say about the Nepal air disaster?

3. Answer any two of the following questions:

- (a) (i) Discuss *The Murder of Roger Ackroyd* as a social critique in the guise of a murder mystery.
